Littletown Primary Academy Uniform

Trousers – dark grey Shirts/blouses/polo shirts - light blue Summer dresses- blue/white check Skirts - navy Sweatshirt/jumper/cardigan - navy P.E. top – navy t-shirt P.E. shorts - navy

We ask that children wear sensible, safe and comfortable black shoes (no open toed shoes)

In the interests of health and safety and security, it is preferable that jewellery is not worn - the school accepts no responsibility for such items brought onto the premises.

Limiting the cost of School uniform

We will ensure the number of branded items, or items that have the school logo on, are kept to a minimum and parents and carers are able to 'shop around' for the best value for all other items of uniform. In this way we will make sure our uniform,
